A RESOLUTION OF THE NATIONAL REGISTRY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS APPROVING THE ALS PRACTICE ANALYSIS ADDENDUM.

WHEREAS The National Registry conducted a practice analysis for the paramedic and advanced emergency medical technician certification levels in 2019 to identify and validate the knowledge, skills, and abilities; AND

WHEREAS the National Registry accepted and approved the 2019 ALS Practice Analysis in 20-MOTION-09 in June 2020; AND

WHEREAS the National Registry approved the 61.05 Practice Analysis Policy on June 6, 2021, indicating that all National Registry certification examinations are based on specifications that result from a practice analysis study; AND

WHEREAS the National Registry conducted an addendum to the practice analysis study in 2021; AND

WHEREAS the practice analysis study was conducted according to the Standards for Educational and Psychological Testing and the NCCA guidelines; AND

WHEREAS the current 2019 the ALS Practice Analysis and 2021 addendum for study has been presented for review to the Board of Directors; AND

WHEREAS the Board of Directors desires that the EMS community to know the study has been conducted and that it serves as the basis for adding a clinical judgment domain to the ALS examinations.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the National Registry of EMTs Board of Directors approves the ALS Practice Analysis addendum and authorizes the staff to communicate with the EMS community about the changes being made to the examinations based on the findings of the report.
