Intent

Define the requirements for monitoring the administration of the National Registry's cognitive examinations.

Scope

The policy covers the requirements for the EMR, EMT, AEMT, and Paramedic cognitive examinations.

Definitions

Test network – computer-based testing sites for cognitive examinations.

Test network administrator – vendor selected to administer the cognitive examinations through a network of secure testing sites.

Policy

The National Registry monitors the administration of the cognitive examinations at approved test sites to ensure compliance with policies and procedures for secure and standardized examination administration.

The Standards & Examinations Committee will review, at least annually, reports of cognitive examination administrations to include a summary of the number of examinations administered, accommodations provided, irregularities, complaints, candidate feedback, and results of the test network owner's internal review of test sites.

Rationale

National Registry certification examinations are administered in a secure and standardized manner. The National Registry Board of Directors and staff reserve the right to monitor examination sites to monitor compliance with policies and procedures for secure and standardized examination administration.
