#### Intent

Provide a process for candidates that fail either the cognitive and/or psychomotor examination to request reconsideration based on National Registry failure to follow test administration policies.

## Scope

Applies to candidates that fail the cognitive and/or psychomotor examination and follow established procedures to request reconsideration.

## Definitions

Not applicable

## Policy

Requests from failing candidates are processed in a constructive, impartial, and timely manner. Requests for reconsideration will be investigated as needed, documented, and tracked.

Requesting reconsideration will not result in any discriminatory actions against the candidate.

## Rationale

Candidates are provided with a process for requesting reconsideration if National Registry examination administration policies are not followed to an extent that adversely effects candidate performance.
